We are seeking to appoint a Lecturer in English as a Second Language both to consolidate our undergraduate and postgraduate teaching staff and to strengthen our research portfolio in the field of English Studies. The successful candidate will teach two or three courses/semester and design course materials and assessment tools. This position starts out on a one-year renewable contract.

To succeed in this application, the candidate needs:

- A PhD in teaching English as a foreign language (TEFL), English Studies, Translation Studies, Culture Studies or Media Studies;
- Applied knowledge of current research relevant to L2 teaching and learning, including familiarity with multimodal and web-based technology;
- Excellent written and oral academic communication skills;
- Demonstrated understanding of the communication requirements of humanities and social sciences students;
- Previous experience in higher education level lecturing is highly welcome.

Applicants should furthermore submit the following documentation:

1. Letter of application;
2. CV;
3. A sample of material development (print or digital) and academic writing (maximum 20 pages),
4. A syllabus proposal for teaching English as a Foreign Language to Media Studies students (specifications: the syllabus should be designed for students who have reached the B2 level of the Common European Framework for Languages, and for the duration of one semester and 30 contact hours);
5. Two letters of recommendation.

Incomplete applications will not be considered.
